2 New from Lewis & Wood are these cotton velvets, 'Rooksmoor', £74.40 a metre, designed to complement the company's plain linens, taffetas and wools. Of 16 colours, pictured, from top of pile, are hellebore, inca, myrtle, sea holly and marmara.

3 This soft, speckled runner, 'Roshven VII', is hand-knotted in Kathmandu from hand-spun Tibetan wool and silk-dyed with non-toxic, non-allergenic and environmentally friendly vegetable or mineral dyes. It is also available as a carpet, and costs £600 a square metre, from Morgan Ashard.

4 'Silvy's' dressing table, by Julian Chichester, is lined with sycamore veneer and covered in a fine vellum

with an unusual, dappled, purple pattern. It measures 72 (with mirror down) x 100 x 47 cm, and costs £1,427. 5 During his holiday in Provence, Patrick Frey discovered these platters by local ceramicist Vincent Buffile. There are six designs in total, each of which measures 50 x 55 cm, and costs £595, at Pierre Frey.

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
